Fall City Citizens for Rural Preservation respectfully submit for your review copies of 328 signatures collected between June 20th and June 28th requesting consideration during the preparation and approval of the Fall City Sub Area Plan and 2012 King County Comprehensive Plan.

We the citizens of Fall City feel the existing Fall City Subarea Plan adopted by the council in 2000 has served the rural town of Fall City well. In particular we request the following emphasis in preserving that plan:











- **No sewer/wastewater in residential zone and no sewer tight line to Carnation, Snoqualmie or King County Metro.**
- **Although a few small adjustments may be needed to the business district, there are several vacant business buildings in Fall City and therefore expansion/encroachment of the business district into existing residential areas will not improve business viability.**
- **Apartments, condos and townhouses are not consistent with rural town character and no new permits should be issued.**
- **The existing town boundary should remain unchanged. No special rezoning should be granted using the King Co Comprehensive Plan/Fall City Subarea Plan update as a means to sidestep the permit/hearing process.**
