Presidents report for FCUAC Jan 25th,

Due to the snow storm our meeting for Jan 18th was canceled and postponed to today. Thanks go Pastor Don Burnett for accommodating us. Our third Wednesday of the month meeting days at the church are the same night that the Church holds weekly youth night meetings. This can become loud and some of our members have a hard time hearing during our meetings which is a distraction. I met with James Ross the Church Administrator about optional meeting times. It appears that Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays of the third week of the month are available. If we choose to change our meeting times those are our options at May Valley. I made it very clear that we support the youth night activities. The Public Engagement Goal team met once so far this month and is working towards an action plan to ready to submit soon. The next meeting is on the 31st and is slated to be a working meeting. In other words the team needs to produce a deliverable item.

Yesterday I attended a meeting hosted by Metro. This concerned planning for alternative service options for bus routes that are underutilized and using those resources to supplement routes that are underserved. A number of options are available including expanded DART system, community shuttles, ACCESS busses, and taxi scrip to mention a few. Unfortunately the underperforming routes have not yet been identified. Although a sample bus route has been given, Route 224 from Redmond to Fall City. Rider cost on this route is \$23.00 per person.
