**Call to Order:** Vice President Edie Jorgensen called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.

**Public Comment:** Tom Pruitt discussed a proposed King County Ordinance designed to deal with nuisance tenants.

**Sheriff's Report:** Deputy Jeff Harmon provided his monthly police report. He mentioned that a press conference on the proposed ordinance discussed by Mr. Pruitt was well-attended and had the full support of landlords and law enforcement. Deputy Harmon informed the audience that more information on community law enforcement activity can be obtained in his monthly newsletter.

**Guest Speaker - Faye Brooks:** Faye Brooks, a former Precinct Commander of the King County Sheriff's Department, provided information about the National Coalition Building Institute. Ms. Brooks works for NCBI, which offers conflict resolution workshops. She informed the audience that the next NCBI training workshop is scheduled for next Tuesday at the Maple Valley Police Precinct.

**Treasurer's Report:** Treasurer Rich Nelson provided his monthly report.

**Secretary's Report:** Secretary David Braswell presented the May minutes. Sean K. moved that the minutes be approved; Sharon S. seconded the motion. Motion unanimously carried.

**Election Committee Report:** Election Committee Chair Pete E. provided an update on the Election Committee's recent activity. He informed the Council that Valencia precinct was divided into 2 precinct since the last election: Valencia and Briarwood precincts. He also told us that the Shamrock and Liberty annexations will cause the FCUAC to lose more voters.

A discussion of By-law changes followed. One topic discussed was whether proposed election procedures should be presented before existing election procedures are stricken. Pete E. also mentioned that re-apportionment of districts needs to be taken care of in the near future.

**New Business:** Sean K. informed the Council that he had submitted an application to the King County Solid Waste Advisory Committee.

Motion: Marshall B. moved that the Council approve and send a letter of support for Sean to serve on the King County Solid Waste Advisory Committee. Sharon S. seconded the motion. Motion unanimously carried (Sean K. and Doug B. abstaining).

**Election Committee Meeting:** Pete E. announced that the next Election Committee meeting is scheduled for Monday, June 23rd, at 6:30 p.m. at Vince's Coffee on NE 4th.
