Sheriff's Report, Reagan Dunn, KCDOT Bandaret Bridge (Issaquah Creek)

Reagan Dunn talked at length on the following subjects he has sponsored and/or supported:

Safer Neighborhoods Ordinance: This ordinance sponsored by Reagan Dunn depends on cooperation between neighbors, by reporting illegal activity ("problem houses") and the sheriff's office (call 911) in unincorporated King County. The Sheriff will notify the landlord when a serious crime is committed on the property. After three separate notifications of crime on rented property in a six-month period, owners would be required to take reasonable action to prevent the recurrence of such crime or face fines themselves.

May Creek Clean Up: Cleaned up complete and now planting reed grass.

Four Flood Response Reform legislations:

Stockpiling Sandbags This directs the King County Water and Land Resources Division to identify strategic locations accessible to residents of flood prone areas for stockpiling materials and equipment for sandbags,

Public Notification Dunn has filed a motion calling for a review of the current county notification process and proposals for improvements to be submitted to the council by May.,

Interagency Coordination legislation Councilmember Dunn and co-sponsor Councilmember Lambert, seeks a review and report on current coordination and communications efforts between county, state or federal agencies whose actions may impact flood protection efforts.

Illegal Dumping- There is a fine of \$100.00 for abandoning vehicles on King County Property and an additional fine of \$100.00 per cubic foot if KC has to remove the abandoned vehicle. If anyone see's an abandoned vehicle notify the Sheriff (911) or drop by the ERP Store front (12644 164th Ave SE. Renton WA) or email Tara at (tara.wilson@kingcounty.gov).

Department of Transportation (DOT) - Bandaret Bridge (Issaquah Creek):

This bridge is constructed entirely of timber and is approaching the end of its useful life. It carries increasingly heavy traffic and is problematic to repair, causing disruptions to traffic flow.

Construction has already begun and is scheduled to complete by November 2009.

Scope: Replace the existing bridge and the approach roadways;
Build new bridge in same place as existing.

- Staged construction:
 - Build South portion.
 - Shift traffic to South portion.
 - Demolish old bridge, build North portion.
 - Shift traffic to new bridge.
- Approximate construction cost \$2,000,000
