Meeting Convened at 7:04pm. Volunteer to take notes on meeting tonight, Edie J.

**Guests present-** Marissa Alegria, Kevin Brown, Brian Sleight from King County, Shari Sung. ommunity members.

**Public Comment:** Questions and discussion of the status of Squak Mountain/Serenity Estates property logging or development. The logging/Forest Practices permit has been withdrawn at this time by Mr. Erickson. Folks were directed to Squak.com for information that has been developed or provided by the Issaquah Alps Club, which has an interest in the trail use potential of the property. Shari Sung introduced herself and indicated her plan to run for King County Council for District 9 and her desire to find out about issues in the Four Creeks area. A request was made to King County representatives to consider measuring and monitoring the water quality and quantity at Cemetary Pond as a result of the activity on the “auto sales lot” on 128<sup>th</sup> and 1<sup>st</sup> 64<sup>th</sup>; Cemetary Pond is part of the FCUAC and CARE memorandum of understanding for stewardship.

**Program: Kevin Brown, Director of KC Parks and Recreation** presented information on the Executive’s proposal for the 2014-2019 Parks levy a handout with comparison data from previous and the proposed levies. Brian Sleight answered various questions regarding surface water management and stream flows. A request was made for a report back, when finished, of the McDonald Creek study.

**Communications Secretary. Atlas Project with Green River Community College:** . Software was available for a significant discount to students enrolled at GRCC and would be sought for Tom’s use in producing community maps as recommended by the Atlas committee.. The Committee also suggested possible stipends for students for travel expenses to do on the ground study of areas to be mapped in their projects.

**Recording Secretary:** Minutes for January 2013 presented: Edie J. moved, Tom C.. 2nded approval with addition of Paul D. as member of the Atlas Committee.. Unanimous approval. Minutes of February 2013 meeting introduced. Tom C. moved and Vern R. 2nded approval as written. Unanimously approved.

**Treasurer:** Draft budget provided to members was tabled for approval until Treasurer is present at March meeting.

**President:** IRS has not yet responded to the application made for 501(c)3 status, made over a year ago. Tom and Pete will coordinate data to be used in seeking assistance from a local congressman to get action or at least a clear status report.
