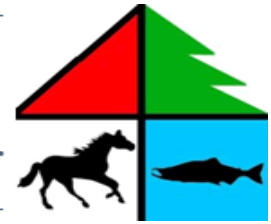

Public Comment: none

Program: Meagan Elliot, KC Executive's Office described the effort called One King County to survey residents for their input into the 5 year strategic plan. Materials were distributed to post or hand to others so they would visit the website and participate. \$125,000 was budgeted for the survey.

Rick Tokarzewski returned with materials discussed the previous month on Emergency Management. He compiled the examples of organizations presenting CERT classes, training people to have the preparedness needed for emergencies. He also discussed the nature of the classes in the multi-week course. He said there was also an on-line class available, but recommended the in-person training to get the most out of the training. Another item of help in an emergency is available to those with land-lines registered with Emergency Management, who can use technology to send a voice blast to advise folks of the state of things.

Other business and reports

A short discussion occurred on the now-three-year plan/MOU between Care, FCUAC and King County. There being very few in attendance, Vern recommended tabling action until November.

Communications Secretary. Atlas Project with Green River CC. Tom is investigating methods to distribute stipends or whatever is appropriate. He is seeking a cpa familiar with non-profits to advise on mechanisms & procedures.
