Brainstorming of ideas for possible grant submissions included historical research of all the logging train tracks (and any remaining artifacts) over Tiger Mountain with reference to current landmarks; Oral history of the May Valley by the red barn noting also there is a railroad easement on the north side of Highway 900 from Renton to Issaquah; review and documentation of the history of May Valley using photographs still existing in the collections of the long time valley residents.
