Guests present- Roger Paulsen, citizen active in the pending development activity affecting a three-way stop on 156th/154th corridor.. Ronda Bryan and Debi Eberle, CARE members.

Public Comment:

Program: Roger Paulsen provided an overview of the development proposed near the "three-way stop" intersection and the traffic analyses/required and/or completed as part of the permitting for new building and street access to 156th.
