Greg Thomas, King County Sheriff's Office; Marissa Alegria, KC CSA Program; Debi Eberle, CARE Organization; Brian Thomas, former Four Creeks member and elected official; a dozen members of the public.

Program:

Captain Greg Thomas, who helped re-open the precinct office in Maple Valley, was introduced and he gave lots of information, advice and cautions, and answered many individualized questions from the public and council members. Highlights to note:

If you have questions call the County phone of Captain Thomas at 206-423-1485 (desk phone: 206-263-9160, though he's most often on the road or in the field.)

You can request a Radar Trailer (there's a long list and you only get it for a couple days). Radar Trailer has as much effectiveness is slowing speeders as writing tickets.

Watchdog.com is the sex offender map. Suggested it be checked once a week for changes.

For issues with drugs and gangs, there are no special resource focused teams. Report it to Greg Thomas at the desk phone; it really helps if you provide a name to go along with a notification of a problem so the Special Emphasis Team has something to work with.

Old Business: A proposal had been presented to make a bylaw change in February, but weren't "in writing" at the time. Pete prepared changes "in writing" for the March meeting for consideration. Article IV proposed its title be changed to just say "Voting" and delete reference to Representation; and to change the requirement to be a registered voter to instead be "of legal voting age" and have a primary residence in the service area of Four Creeks UAC.
