

## Scenario

A 7.2 magnitude earthquake has occurred in the Seattle seismic fault zone, causing significant, wide-spread damage in the Puget Sound Area.

- Cellular and land-line communication is unavailable.
- Many roads and bridges have been damaged or blocked by fallen trees.

### IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD:

- There is major damage to a few of the dwelling units; at least one dwelling unit is on fire; some structures have been dislodged from their foundations.
- Some trees have fallen; vehicle evacuation routes are blocked and/or damaged.
- Power, gas, and water service infrastructure has been damaged; utilities are unavailable.
- There are quite a few injuries, some more than can be treated with first aid.
- Calls for help can be heard.
- There are pets, some outside their households.
- Professional first responders, including fire, medical and utility repair, will be unavailable for 3 to 5 days or longer.
- Lakes and ponds in the area have had very high waves washing ashore.
- There are household individuals inside and outside the neighborhood when the emergency occurred.
