

Minutes of the September 04, 2002 Special Meeting of the Four Creeks U.A.C.

The meeting could not convene at 7:00 PM as scheduled, because the bylaws provide that at least six councilmembers must be in attendance to establish a quorum. At 7:00 PM the initial attendees were Oscar Bandelin, President, Marshall Brenden, Vice-President, Gwendolyn High, Transportation Representative, David Rockabrand, District 1, and Tom Tregoning, District 6. At 7:20 PM, David Dahlin, At Large District, arrived. The meeting was called to order at 7:20 PM.

Mr. Dahlin stated his intention to resign, effective immediately. He stated that, given the magnitude of his outside responsibilities at present, he could not in good conscience continue to serve on the Board. He did not want to serve unless he could give his service the time and attention it deserved.

Since Mr. Dahlin intended to resign, the Council would once again be without a quorum. A motion was made to adjourn, was seconded, and passed at 7:23 PM. Mr. Dahlin's resignation was accepted, and he departed. Public notice of his open seat is hereby given.

Oscar Bandelin formed an action committee comprised of himself and the other four remaining councilmembers. This action committee drafted a letter to Executive Sims on the West Nile virus issue. Cross copies will be sent to David Irons and Greg Kipp, King County Health Department
