Discussion of Annual UAC Forum of September 30, 2003:

- It is very difficult to distill a full year's worth of work into one meeting. Perhaps 2 to 4 times per year would be more effective. It was suggested 1)UAC presidents meet more often to coordinate cooperation 2)Regular emails of agenda to all the UAC presidents to keep all up to date
- A write-up of our experience as a Hosting Handbook would be useful to all the UACs so that the process does not have to be rediscovered each year.
