Unfinished Business

• Marshall B. reported that he had attended the first hearing of the proposed CAO and related ordinance updates before the full King County Council. There were 97 speakers and the testimony lasted 5 and a half hours. Marshall reported that he estimated testimony to be roughly 5:1 against adoption of the proposed updates. The main controversy remains focused on the increased buffers, 50-65% no touch, and the validity of the science quoted in support of the proposed updates. It is expected that the Council will vote on the legislation on October 25th. If the legislation passes, lawsuits are anticipated.

New Business

Dick F. reported having received a notice that King County is proposing to eliminate the Open Space tax exemptions. The extent of this proposed elimination is not known. The notice he received was sent by a home-owners group in Hi-Valley. There is no information about whether this is proposed throughout the county. Dick will try to find out more and will report.
